Summary:

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Prepare snacks and teaching materials for the after school program.
- Receive students from their school bus upon their arrival at the program.
- Provide basic hygiene and self-care needs for those students who need them.
- Working and engaging with the students while they are at our program.
- Follow all safety rules and ensure the safety of our students and volunteers.
- Plan, facilitate and teach different class curriculums (ie. cooking, life skills, arts and craft, science, social skills, music & dance).
- Promote a positive environment for our students to learn in.
- Assist in creating obtainable goals and objectives for each of our students.
- Supervise and mentor our volunteers.
- Supervise and manage student behaviors as it is necessary.
- Help with daily clean up of after school program facility.
- Attend monthly staff meetings.
- Participate in parent-teacher conferences 2 times a year.

Qualifications and Skills:

- > Must have a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must be reliable, a team player, has good communication skills and be able to work with minimal supervision.
- May need to work on certain necessary Saturdays or Sundays for special events
- Preferably some experience or studies in education, special needs or with school-aged students.

Must be fluent in English. Cantonese or Mandarin speaking is a plus but not required.
