PROGRAM HOURS

The Program is open from Monday to Friday from 3-6pm. We accommodate for minimum day schedules. Our school calendar coincides with the Fremont Unified School District. Students must attend a minimum of 3 days per week.

FOR WHOM

- School aged students with special needs between ages 6-22
- Able to perform in a 1:3 ratio
- Without injurious behavior to self or others
- Fully potty trained
- Without medical complications
- Must have transportation to and from program.

OUR PROGRAM

Our goal is to provide a safe, fun and healthy enrichment program for children with special needs during after school hours. We offer positive guidance, assistance and encouragement to help students reach their maximum potential. We believe that all families and individuals can live an active and full life as members in the community, regardless of ability. We put equal emphasis on the spiritual, intellectual, emotional, social, and physical development of each unique child.

WHAT WE DO

With a staff to student ratio of 1:3, we strive to provide specific care for K-12th children with developmental disabilities or special needs. All children are unique in their development, and any definition of typical development must constantly evolve as we discover new knowledge.
